

## Padding the Caledonian Canal?

We understand that some of the Great Glen's Way-farers are seeking a wilderness experience and want to 'wild camp' on their journey along the Caledonian Canal.

The following informal pitches are available for use by individuals and *small* groups with *small* tents for *single* nights only (we reserve the right to deny access as space is very limited) :

<b>Moy Bridge (West)</b> (max 4 tents or 8 people)	<b>Gairloch (by picnic area)</b> (max 10 tents or 20 people)
<b>Laggan Locks (South shore)</b> (max 5 tents or 10 people)	<b>Aberchalder (South)</b> (max 3 tents or 6 people)
<b>Kytra (South)</b> (max 3 tents or 6 people)	<b>Seaport Marina (Inside fence)</b> (max 4 tents or 8 people)

Please respect the Canal's status as a Scheduled Ancient Monument by leaving your pitches litter-free and by not setting campfires. The Canal is also a workplace; please ensure your tents don't block access to locks, bridges, toilets or other buildings and paths - if in doubt, please check with our staff.

Keys to the Canal's toilet blocks may be purchased in advance by phoning 01463 725500. These toilets can be very busy - please leave them clean and tidy and don't use them for drying equipment, cooking or sleeping!!
