

The first ever Glasgow Canal Festival is coming to North Glasgow on Saturday 22nd July!

The Forth & Clyde Canal between Applecross Basin and Speirs Wharf will spring to life between 11am and 5pm with street theatre, a street food village, canoe taster sessions, guided cycle tours, craft workshops, heritage and wildlife tours, urban games workshops, live music and a behind the scenes look inside local landmarks.

The highlight of the day will be the Glasgow Canal Festival Dragon Boat Race. Come along and cheer on the teams competing across a 200m course to be crowned the Glasgow Canal's first ever dragon boat champions!

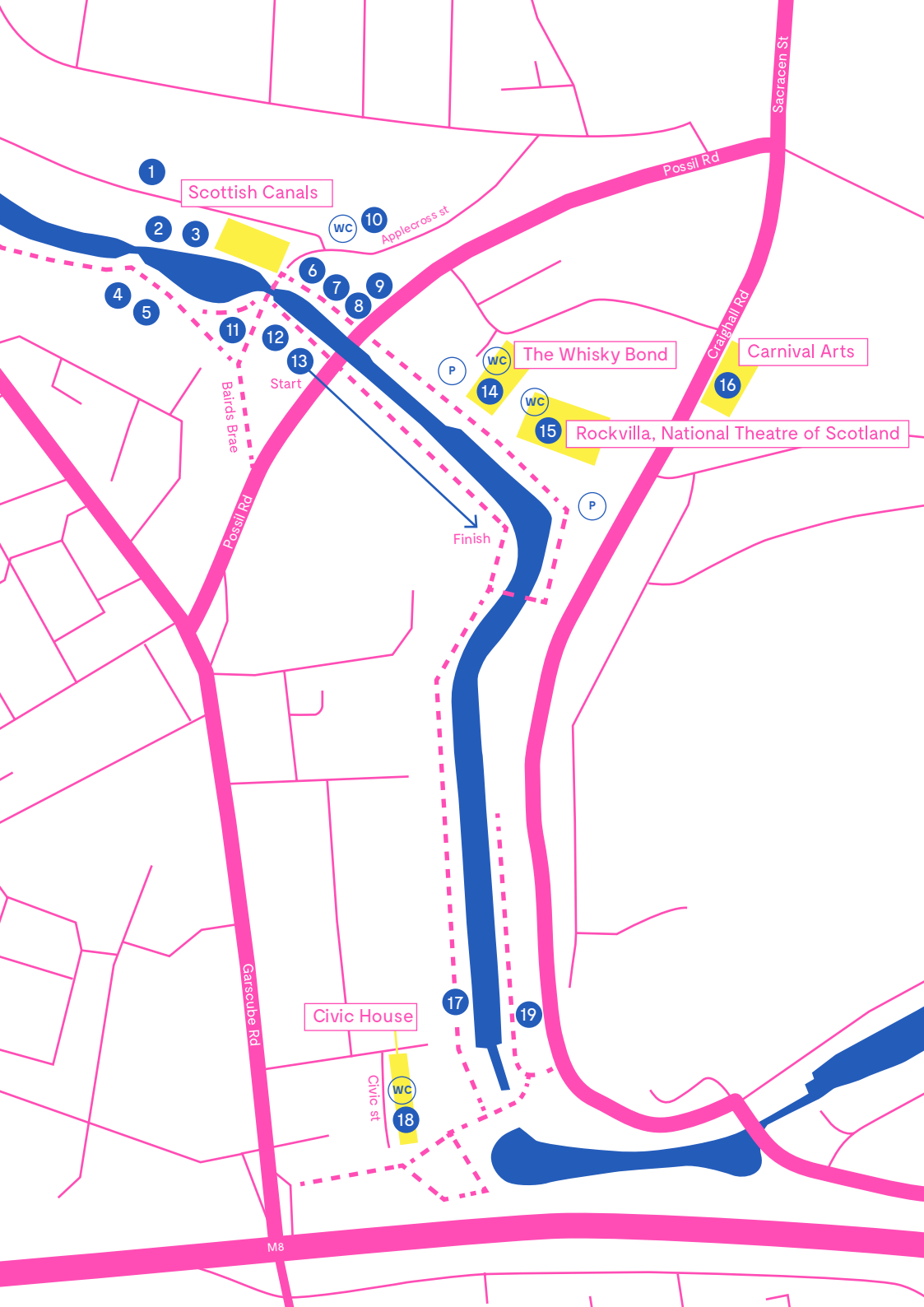
